APPLICATION FOR MARRIAGE CEREMONY

Those who wish ISGVF Imam to preside over their Marriage Ceremony in accordance with the Holy Qur'an and the Sunnah of Prophet, Muhammad (SAW), must submit the following information at least two weeks before the scheduled ceremony.

The bride and groom must have a <u>valid civil marriage license</u> and this must be submitted to ISGVF before the Marriage Ceremony or ISGVF reserves the right to refuse to conduct the marriage. In addition, if the bride and groom are unknown to the Imam, he may request a letter of reference from an ISGVF member or a prominent member from the community.

There must be no alcohol, drugs or other prohibited (Haram) materials or food present at the site of the marriage.

The Husband must be a Muslim and the bride must either be a Muslim or one of the People of the Book. The Imam must be permitted to interview the bride and groom prior to the ceremony to counsel the bride and groom and ascertain their beliefs.

This application must be signed by either the bride or groom or one of their parents indicating compliance with the above conditions.

Note that a Hadiya of \$500 is payable to ISGVF for the Imam to preside over the Ceremony. This fee should be paid with the application.
